Best Practice # 1: Awareness campaign on 'Use of Sanitary Pads'

Objective: Making rural women and girls aware towards the importance of using sanitary pads for maintaining hygiene.

Evidence of Success: As a result of the continuous efforts, a large number of girls and women residing in the nearby villages started using sanitary pads and also volunteered for spreading awareness among other females in their circle.

Best Practice # 2: Special drive for 'Clean and Green Campus'

Objective: 1. Making the college campus clean.

2. Making the campus lush green.

Context: Cleanliness and greenery are issues concerning one and all. It is important for all of us to keep our surroundings clean and green not only from aesthetic viewpoint but also from that of environment. Therefore, the college management decided to initiate a campaign for 'Clean and Green Campus'.

Description: Students and faculties volunteered for conducting regular cleanliness drive in the campus on Saturdays. It not only made learners aware on the importance of cleanliness in surroundings but also resulted in a clean campus.

Apart from this, the college fraternity also conduct sapling plantation drive in the college time to time. All elite guests visiting the college are insisted on planting a sapling at least on their first visit. On special occasions, the faculties and students also plant saplings thereby contributing to the cause of green campus. As part of this, an Oxyzone has also been developed in the campus.

Evidence of Success: There has been a drastic change in ambience of the premises in last one year or so. It is for everyone to see that the campus is much more clean and there are a large number of shade and fruit bearing trees offering a pleasant feel.
